- 1. This scholarship is awarded based on the candidate's character, scholastic records, evidence of intellectual promise, leadership ability and need for financial assistance.
- 2. Applicant must be a high school senior residing in NC and a citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States.
- 3. Applicants must be in the top quarter of their class.
- 4. Applicants must submit complete application packet by Friday, January 16, 2026 at 6:00 pm, (late applications will not be accepted) and must be available to meet with the Statesville Woman's Club selection committee for the interview Sunday, January 25, 2026. The exact <u>time</u> of interview will be determined for each applicant closer to the date. Interview time slots will begin at 1:00 pm. Each candidate will be given a specific time slot.
- 5. Our local winner <u>must</u> be available to compete in **SSCS District** competition (February 21, 2026, in Hickory, NC or ZOOM).
- 6. The scholarship must be used at a four-year college or university in the state of North Carolina. It can also be awarded to a community college student who plans to transfer to a four-year school to earn a degree.

Most current high school transcriptclass rank with number of students in classes listedand grade point averages, weighted and unweighted.
Financial Need Documentation: submit the FAFSA. If FAFSA is not available, you can submit a most recent copy of Federal Tax Return for applicant's parents and applicant. Please mark through Social Security numbers so they are not visible to the interviewers.
